CapTrust Grant application submitted on 3/14 to help fund lower campus playground upgrades.

The United Way experienced one major business donor closing. Consequently, they are having to cut back on grant awards across the board. The MHCO grant for this year was reduced from \$20,000 to \$10,000.

Arby's Grant Award for ILP Furniture has increased by \$2000 to \$16,100 due to their donation receipts.

Grant apps are being developed for the TDA Homecoming marketing and the NC Community Foundation.

Paycom provides grant options for non-profits utilizing their system. MHCO will submit applications requesting they be a sponsor for Homecoming and the Gala in 2026.
