### Administrative and Management Standards

Financial Management (FIN), Governance (GOV) or Administration & Management (AM) (for Public State Systems), Human Resources (HR), Performance and Quality Improvement (PQI), Risk Prevention and Management (RPM)

- FIN** There is a culture of accountability. The organization has focused on strong internal controls to ensure responsible financial management. The organization has a strong vision and plan to adapt through responsible and creative investing for the long-term. The organization upholds accurate financial reporting, regulatory compliance, and operational efficiency.
- GOV** The organization has a highly engaged, knowledgeable, and committed Board of Directors, as well as an Executive Team. Both are focused on the strategic direction and financial stability of the organization. Both teams have a wealth of longevity with the organization and are committed to furthering the organization's mission. There are strong processes and policies in place to ensure the Board of Directors is informed of the inner workings of the organization.
- HR** The Human Resources team spends time focusing on the retention of employees, as well as staff satisfaction. The HR team has implemented changes based on feedback received from staff members, which is impressive. They also take the time to explain if they cannot implement a suggested change and what they may be able to do instead. There is time spent to ensure that there is a flexible schedule when available, supportive supervision, and mental health resources available to staff members. The personnel records are complete and well-organized.
- PQI** There is data-informed decision making. The organization leverages its PQI system to monitor performance targets, program goals, and client outcomes. This ensures decisions are guided by accurate, timely information. There is strong, passionate leadership in the PQI role. The organization actively involves staff across all departments, people served, and key stakeholders in the PQI process to foster shared ownership of quality improvement. The organization sustains a comprehensive PQI framework aligned with its mission, enhancing program quality, staff satisfaction, and positive outcomes for those served.
- RPM** The organization takes a proactive organization-wide approach to risk management to ensure that people feel safe and services are provided in spaces that are free from

risks. The organization has hired a Resource Officer. The risk management plan is comprehensive and reviewed consistently. Policies and procedures are in place to ensure that there is clear guidance on how to handle critical events, emergency preparedness, and compliance with federal and state child welfare regulations. Leadership works actively to mitigate risks and adapt prevention measures in real time.

## Service Delivery Administration Standards

Administrative and Service Environment (ASE), Behavior Support and Management (BSM), Client Rights (CR), Training and Supervision (TS)

- ASE** The organization ensures the facilities and services are accessible to all individuals while prioritizing respect, inclusion, and personal dignity, which shows its commitment to accessibility. It has a safe and trauma-informed environment. The organization maintains physical and psychological safety through trauma-informed practices, fostering trust and well-being for clients and staff. The organization upholds strong facility maintenance, safety procedures, and emergency response plans that enhance productivity and ensure uninterrupted, high-quality service delivery.
- CR** The organization has commitment to dignity and respect. The organization upholds practices that honor each client's personal dignity, ensuring respectful and ethical service delivery at all levels. The organization maintains rigorous safeguards for client information, promoting trust and compliance with legal and ethical standards. The organization fosters open communication and collaborative relationships with clients, supporting their rights and reinforcing professional ethics.
- PRG** The organization is strong in its ability to ensure the security, accuracy, and accessibility of case records. The organization ensures the highest standards of client confidentiality. Policies are in place to ensure that record access is limited and records are clear, timely, and in line with state, federal, and COA requirements. The secure EHR has role based permissions with encrypted data storage and regular audits to ensure records are maintained appropriately. There are strong medication controls and administration procedures in place to include secure storage, inventory tracking, and double-verification for administration and disposal. Medication logs are updated in real time and regularly reviewed to prevent errors and ensure safety for those in care.
- TS** The organization takes training and supervision seriously. The organization works hard to foster a learning culture to equip staff with the knowledge, skills, and support necessary to deliver quality, trauma-informed services to their clients. Onboarding ensures that new employees understand the policies and procedures, as well as their role within the organization. The length of onboarding and orientation is based on the comfort level of staff doing their jobs. Ongoing training is embedded in the organization's culture through mandatory annual training, as well as training as needed. Staff feel that their supervisor is available and active in their development. Supervision is provided on a consistent basis.

## Service Standards

- CSE The Community Support Center is a beautiful cottage that is decorated nicely and welcoming. The staff working in the center is engaging, friendly, knowledgeable, and full of ideas to expand services in the future. This center is a true asset to the organization and its clients, but also to the community as a whole. They are meeting a true community need.
- GLS The organization has trauma-informed, person-centered care. The organization provides group living environments that prioritize safety, healing, and individualized support, rooted in trauma-informed practices. The organization promotes community connection and inclusion by offering care and rehabilitation services within supportive, community-based group settings. The organization delivers structured, high-quality treatment and supervision tailored to residents' short- and long-term needs, enhancing stability and positive outcomes.
- YIL These services are a true strength of the organization. They have greatly improved their ability to provide a continuum of care by having these services for their youth. The staff are engaging, energetic, passionate, and truly proud of their work and the program. The structured support provided to the young people is unmatched. The organization is giving young adults a leg up by teaching them how to be independent and take care of themselves once they are out of care. The services are truly impressive.
